1.0 Introduction

On Sunday, November 5, 2017, the United States Postal Service implemented the following software change(s):

2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

There is no new Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should use Mail.dat client version 46.0.0.0 PROD.

The current Mail.dat client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

3.0 PostalOne! System - Corrections to Known Issues

3.1 Electronic Data Exchange

For Periodicals (PS Form 3541) submitted by Mail.XML, processing was updated to correctly calculate the In-County price for Periodicals postage statement lines A1 and A2. Previously, Mail.XML processing was incorrectly subtracting the advertising pounds from the Section A pound lines. 11659 (19151-R)

3.2 Full-Service MicroStrategy Reports

Performance has improved for the procedures that populate the Nesting Sampling Validation metrics on the Mail Owner/Mail Preparer Scorecard. Previously, these procedures sometimes failed due to slow performance. As a result, the Nesting Sampling Validation metrics did not refresh with new data on days when the procedures failed. 11650

3.3 Postal Wizard

- The Simplified Postal Wizard Mail Owner/Account Holder Search functionality was updated to include results for Cost Center types Business Mail Entry Unit (BMEU), Detached Mail Unit (DMU), and Satellite (SAT) facilities.

- This only applies to the Testing Environment for Mailers (TEM). The Simplified Postal Wizard interface was
 updated to correct an issue related to generating a blank page in place of the Summary page when users click
 Next on the Rates page while entering a postage statement in the TEM environment. 11654 (19152-R)
