#### **1.0 Introduction**

On Sunday, November 19, 2017, the United States Postal Service will implement the following software change:

• PostalOne! System Release 46.0.2.0

These Pre-Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems.

The sections titled *Corrections to Known Issues* are derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs) for inclusion in these releases.

This document is prepared based on the knowledge available at the time of its publication and any element may be subject to change prior to publication.

#### 2.0 Mail.dat Client Support

Please note the following regarding the Mail.dat client download.

There is no new Mail.dat client version with this release. Users should continue to use Mail.dat client version 46.0.0.0\_PROD.

The current Mail.dat Client may be downloaded from the Business Customer Gateway (BCG) using the following path: Mailing Services → Electronic Data Exchange [Go to Service] → Mail.dat download (Windows 32-bit, Windows 64-bit or Solaris).

### 3.0 PostalOne! System – Corrections to Known Issues

#### 3.1 Business Reply Mail (BRM)

For Postcards, Business Reply Mail (BRM) processing will be updated to properly recalculate the rate from Qualified BRM (QBRM) to Basic BRM when a permit has insufficient funds or unpaid fees. 11643

#### 3.2 Electronic Data Exchange

For postage statements submitted by Mail.XML and claiming an incentive discount, Mail.XML processing will be updated to properly account for the Full-Service discount prior to including any incentive discount. Currently, the process is failing to identify postage statement detail records with the Full-Service discount prior to calculating the incentive award. As a result, some postage statements are receiving a larger discount than they are eligible to receive. 11672 (19170-R)

#### 3.3 Postage Statement Processing

Postage statement processing logic will be updated to correctly handle adjustments for statements eligible for autofinalization. Currently when a customer submits a mailing that is eligible for auto-finalization, a debit adjustment is created for the difference between postage affixed and postage due regardless of whether the value of postage affixed is less than postage due. The logic will be corrected to only create the adjustment if the value of postage affixed is less than postage due. 11714 (19201-R)

#### 3.4 Postal Wizard

Postal Wizard will be updated to modify the logic for retrieval of ZIP Codes to account for the rare case when a Finance Number has no ZIP Code associated with its Address. Currently, if this contingency occurs, Postal Wizard generates a blank page instead of retrieving the ZIP Code directly from the finance record. 11667 (19166-R)
